# We're making St. Joe's history... thanks to you!

Help keep the Promise.



St. Joseph's Health Centre is celebrating a historic milestone. Our community has donated over \$100 million to help us keep an important Promise first made almost 100 years ago – to always be here to care for our west-end neighbours.

This outpouring of support from our community has been incredible. It speaks to the great work of our staff and physicians. Most donors give because they've had care at St. Joe's. They were born here, had care here, brought their children to us when they were ill, or have spent time with loved ones at St. Joe's. This lifetime of care prompted almost 70,000 donations from our west-end neighbours.

Leading the Promise Campaign were two west-end Co-Chairs: Victor Dodig, President & CEO, CIBC, and Brendan Shanahan, President and Alternate Governor for the Toronto Maple Leafs. They were born in the west end and St. Joe's has been there for them and their families. Assisting them were our strong group of local leaders also with west-end connections who made up our Campaign Cabinet.

Four years ago, our goal was to raise \$60 million. Today we've raised over \$100 million and have exceeded the goal by 143%. We've had four \$10 million+ gifts, more than almost any other community hospital campaign in Canada. In this special issue, you will see the impact \$100 million has had so far... and there is more to come. We have new facilities throughout St. Joe's for children, women, people with cancer, those who need dialysis, and people of all ages who turn to us for help with their mental health. Construction is also underway on a dedicated breast centre, as well as a palliative care centre that will overlook Lake Ontario.

**This is just the beginning. Read about Promise<sup>100</sup> and how we are renewing our Promise to the west end as we mark our 100th Anniversary in 2021. We are looking to our neighbours to continue to help us and hope you will join us by showing your support so we can be there for you, when you need us most.**

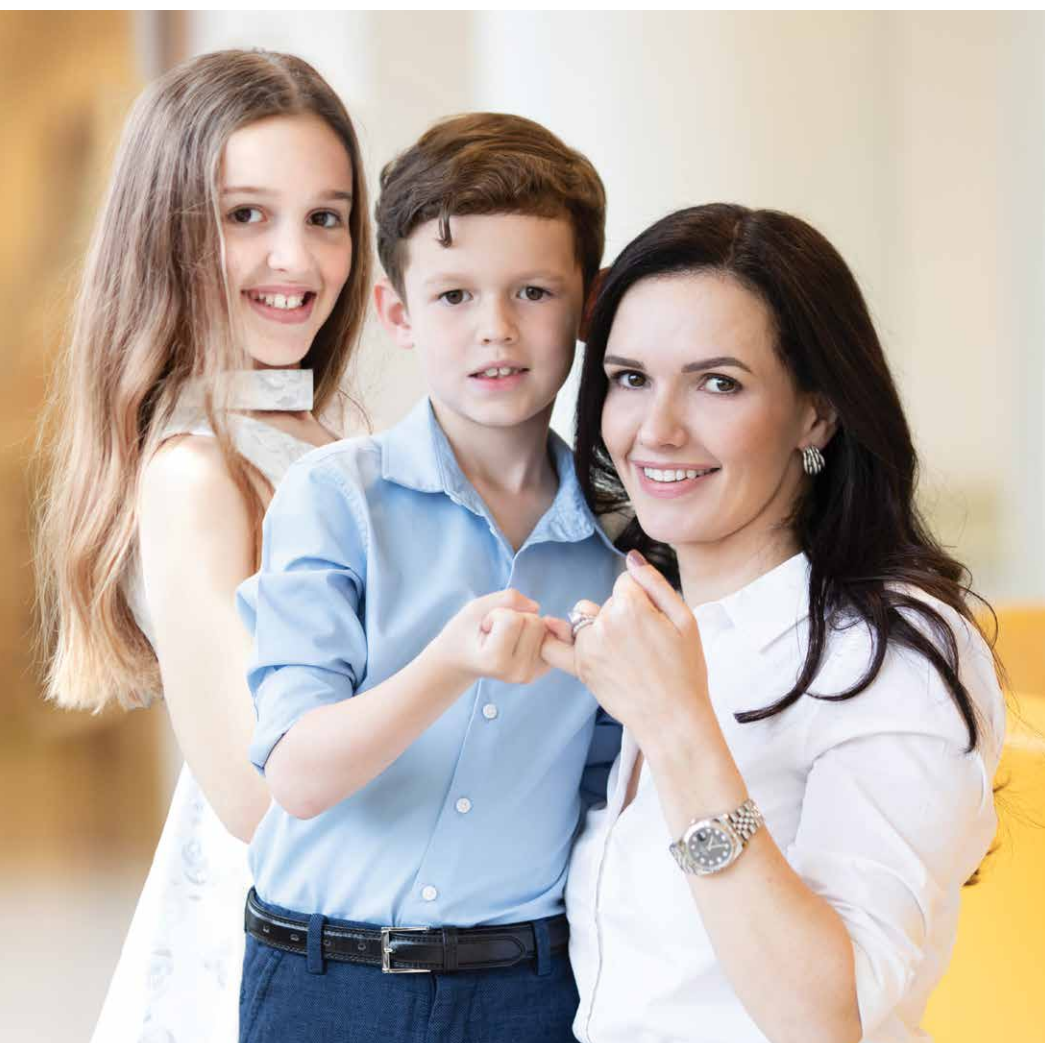

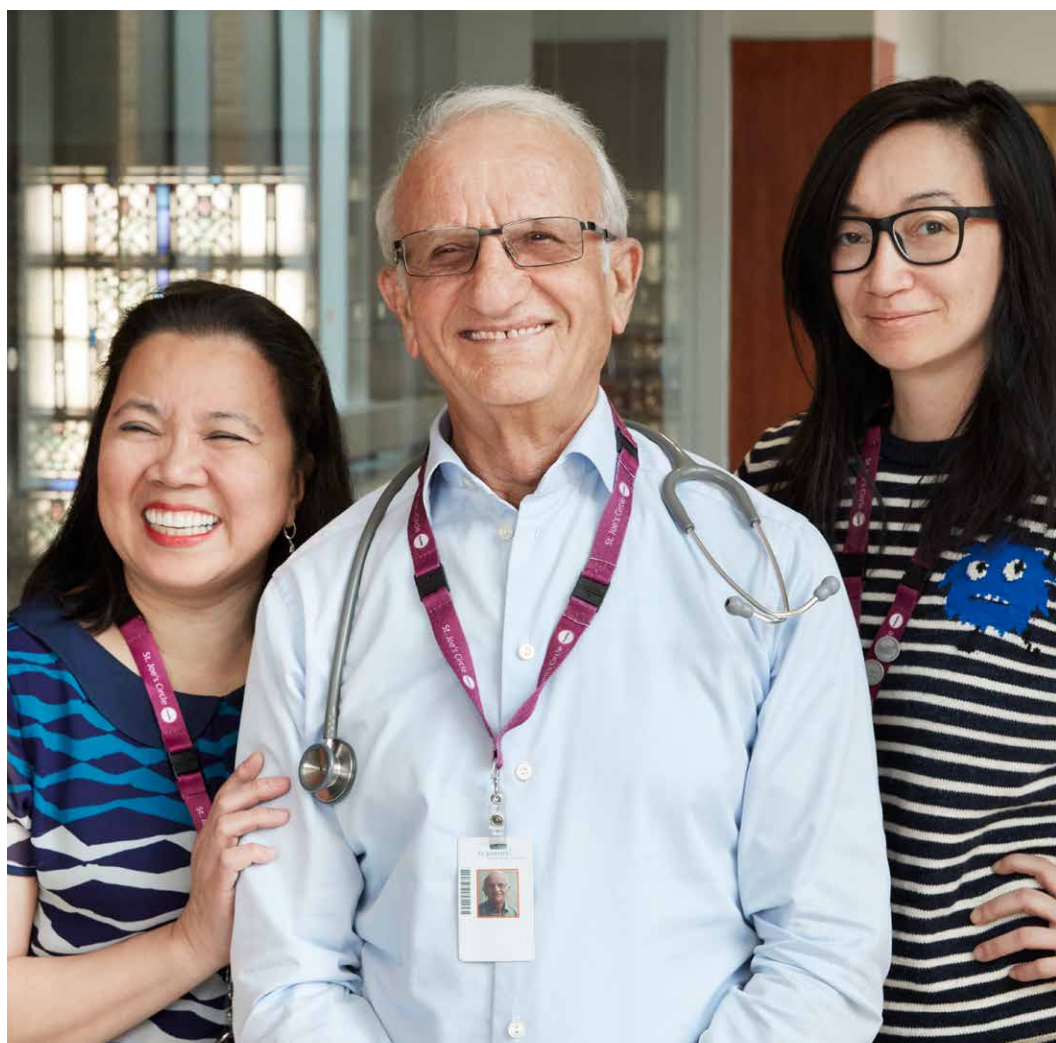

## A Promise is hope.

**Hope for so many people in our community facing mental health challenges.**

Our community has one of the highest concentrations of mental illness in Toronto. St. Joe's has over 70,000 visits every year from people living with mental illness, including more than 6,500 of the most vulnerable who now receive immediate care in our new Mental Health Emergency Services Unit.

"My father was the Chief of General Surgery at St. Joe's when I was a child. I wanted to honour his memory at a place that played an important role in my life, and help build a better space to care for people with mental illness," says Sandy McIntyre. "I know there is a great need for more mental health services in the west end."

## A Promise is personal.

**A new way of caring for women facing breast cancer gives them individualized, timely care so there's less waiting.**

Women in the west end need greater access to breast screening and supportive care. The new Geoffrey H. Wood Foundation Centre of Excellence in Breast Cancer Screening and Treatment will open in 2021 to expand its capacity to screen and diagnose twice the number of women for breast cancer.

"St. Joe's is our family's hospital – it's always been here for us and we're happy to help," says Tamara Bratty, who with her sister-in-law Julia Bratty organize a Ladies' Lunch every spring to support St. Joe's. "We started with raising funds for the children's floor, so when that opened we said 'what's next?' That's when we turned our attention to women's health and a new breast centre."



## A Promise is access.

### More equipment means getting care sooner.

Technology changes quickly and St. Joe's is keeping pace thanks to donor support. A new interventional suite allows our experts to perform image-guided procedures through tiny incisions to ensure a faster recovery for patients. A new fluoroscopy table has cut wait times in half for patients with urology conditions, and we have an Endo-Bronchial Ultrasound, an innovative tool to pinpoint lung cancer without surgery. Now we are expanding our MRI testing with one new machine coming this year and another to follow, thanks to Myron and Berna Garron.

"Our donation emphasizes the importance of community hospitals that are sometimes overlooked," says Myron Garron. "There's a great need to support new equipment to reflect technological advancements in medicine."

## A Promise is reassurance.

### There's comfort in knowing you're in the best hands.

Marilynne Day-Linton says St. Joe's has always been there for her family, and she is happy to be there for St. Joe's by giving to where the needs are greatest.

"I donate and volunteer at St. Joe's because all of us in the west end need great care in our community," says Marilynne Day-Linton, who served on the Foundation Board from 2004 to 2017 and as Chair from 2010 to 2014. "Donating is personal for me. I have spent time in Emergency and throughout St. Joe's with my kids when they were growing up, and my father in his vulnerable senior years. The care here feels different."

### When a loved one is facing their final days, you will have the care and compassion you need at our new palliative care centre.

When the new Lake House Palliative Care Centre opens in 2020, our west-end community will have supportive care for those facing end of life. This is possible thanks to Hans Koehle who never forgot the care shown to him at St. Joe's 60 years ago when he broke his neck diving into shallow water. His transformative gift now grants a wish to his late wife who wanted to support patients and families seeking palliative care as she did.

"My wife received exceptional care at St. Joe's but felt there was always more that could be done to support families at their most difficult time," says Hans Koehle. The new 15,000 square foot centre will have both private rooms and a day hospital for those facing end of life.

## A Promise is solutions.

### A new place to learn, train and share best practices in patient care.

The speed of new information and insights is extremely fast. Did you know our medical teams would need to read thousands of articles each week to keep abreast on the latest in health research and best practices? This is what motivated Foundation Board member Ed Lycklama to make a gift to help. "Our teams didn't have an optimal space that took advantage of today's technology to learn," he says. "It has been a challenge and I wanted to be part of the solution."

The new Learning Centre is now open and features multi-purpose spaces for teaching and larger events. It also takes advantage of technology to further collaboration with other learners around the world.
