This past year, you made receiving care faster and easier for people like Norm Wright, a self-proclaimed “all-too-frequent” patient, who comes to St. Joe’s because “it’s like a second home,” always there for him when he needs it.

Norm regularly relies on St. Joe’s Ambulatory Care Clinic (ACC), recently for the treatment and removal of skin cancer—seeing Dr. Jeanne Zeller at our Dermatology Clinic and Dr. Erin Dahlke at our Mohs Surgery Clinic. This Spring, you helped transform the ACC, creating a space that can accommodate our community’s growing need for fast, easy to access care—and make life better for people like Norm.

The timely care you make possible means coming to the clinic with cancer and leaving without it. It also means less waiting time, and it’s why Norm also chooses to give back to his local hospital. “I come here because I’ve always received great care. St. Joe’s is here for me when I need it, so I am happy to help the cause.”

ST. JOE’S MOHS MICROGRAPHIC SURGERY CLINIC IS ONE OF ONLY FOUR IN ONTARIO THAT OFFER A ONE-STOP EXPERIENCE: DIAGNOSIS, SURGICAL REMOVAL, PATHOLOGY REVIEW, AND RECONSTRUCTION—ALL IN THE SAME VISIT.

Thanks to you, thousands of patients like Norm are already receiving faster, more efficient care as a result of the 100% donor-funded Ambulatory Care Centre renovation that added 30% more space, among other improvements. You helped bring together 26 of St. Joe’s Specialty Outpatient Clinics—including Dermatology, Mohs Micrographic Surgery, Chest/Respiratory, and Plastics—making care more accessible, coordinated, and comfortable for more than 55,000+ patient visits each year.

Tennile Rapley, Clinical Manager of the ACC, has seen firsthand how transformative the ACC’s new space has been for both patients and staff. “Our previous clinic space was outdated and no longer supported the growing needs of our patients or care teams,” Tennile explains. “The exam rooms were small, inefficient, and not designed for the way ambulatory care is delivered.”

“Now, we have purpose-built clinical spaces equipped with advanced technology that improves patient flow, streamlines operations, and allows us to see patients more efficiently and sooner. We’ve doubled our patient seating capacity, expanded our clinic footprint, and created an environment that is functional, welcoming, and designed around patient care. It’s incredible to see the impact a thoughtfully designed space can have on both the patient experience and the care we’re able to provide every day.”

“My life changed in a single moment,” says Mahbub, who recalls stepping outside in the harsh winter weather to check the size of his winter tires—just like any normal day. “Before heading back inside, I picked up a small garbage bag to throw into the bin. Just two steps—nothing unusual. Within fifteen seconds, I was lying on the driveway, with severe pain shooting through my left hip and left hand. When the paramedics arrived, they asked where I wanted to go. I told them clearly: St. Joseph’s Health Centre.”

At our *Tawse Family Emergency Department*, Mahbub was quickly treated for a fractured left hip and hand.

Our Emergency Department transformation was 100% funded by donors like you, and continues to make compassionate, expert care possible, ensuring patients like Mahbub receive timely, tailored care.

After receiving hip surgery, Mahbub was transferred to the *Reactivation Care Unit*, another space where donor support improved care and created more healing spaces this year. “I was fortunate to receive a spacious single room overlooking Lake Ontario—a view that brought peace and hope during my healing. The care on this floor felt like a five star experience, not because of luxury, but because of the dedication and warmth of the people working there.”

That means patients waiting for potentially life-changing news about their health can receive answers sooner, begin treatment earlier, and move forward with their care. This year, donor support helped meet St. Joe’s greatest equipment needs, enabling our teams to deliver the highest standard of care for our patients. From advanced technology that improves accuracy during surgery to upgrading essential equipment that patients rely on during recovery, every dollar means better outcomes and patient experiences. Here are two examples of equipment that donors supported this year:

- Thanks to donors, St. Joe’s purchased a new FLUENT Fluid Management System, a highly advanced system used during hysterectomy procedures. During these procedures, surgeons use fluids to expand the surgical area for improved visibility. The FLUENT system carefully controls these fluids, allowing surgeons to perform this procedure with greater accuracy, lowering the risk of complications, and making recovery faster and more comfortable.
- Upgraded patient beds are an example of how your support is providing safer, more comfortable care for patients. In our Medical Surgical Unit, new beds improve circulation, keep patients safe and comfortable during treatment and recovery, and reduce the risk of pressure injuries (also known as bedsores).

THE BARRETT FAMILY FOUNDATION IS BUILDING A LASTING CULTURE OF IMPROVEMENT AND INSPIRING JOY IN WORK

Seeing the spirit of innovation and improvement at St. Joe's, the Barrett Family Foundation made a historic donation to launch the *Barrett Centre for Quality Improvement (BCQI)*—one of the most ambitious quality improvement programs ever undertaken in a Canadian hospital.

Through the BCQI, teams come together to test ideas, address real-world challenges impacting patients everyday, and transform how care is delivered.

This March marked the end of the first year of the BCQI, and these are the five projects that are now directly improving care for our patients:

- Reducing Discharge Delays: Helping patients get home sooner
- Strengthening After-Visit Summaries: Helping patients go home with greater clarity

- Streamlining OR Turnover: Smoothing patient access to surgery
- Reducing ICU Pressure Injuries: Reducing the risk of pressure injuries through better care and teamwork
- Patient Room Cleans: Supporting safer, healing hospitals stays through Infection Prevention and Control (IPAC)

THE SLAIGHT FAMILY FOUNDATION IS CLOSING THE GAP IN MENTAL HEALTH CARE

Thanks to an incredible \$1.5 million gift, the *Slight Family Foundation Recovery and Reintegration Program* is helping to close the gap in care that young people who have experienced psychosis often face after being in the hospital—meeting a critical need for our west-end community.

An important focus of the gift is strengthening connections between the hospital and local mental

health organizations to promote the continuum of care post-discharge. St. Joe's and LAMP Community Health Centre are long-time collaborators, having worked together on other programs, and they are an exceptional partner for this initiative, housing the program in their space in the west and helping connect these vulnerable young people to programming and services that provide support.

“Funding for mental health initiatives doesn't just improve lives; it strengthens our entire social fabric,” said Gary Slight, President and CEO, The Slight Family Foundation. “One of the issues we heard loud and clear was the disconnect between youth discharged from hospitals and the continued community support or services available to them. Investing in these connecting services and programs is an investment in the well-being and future of our youth.”

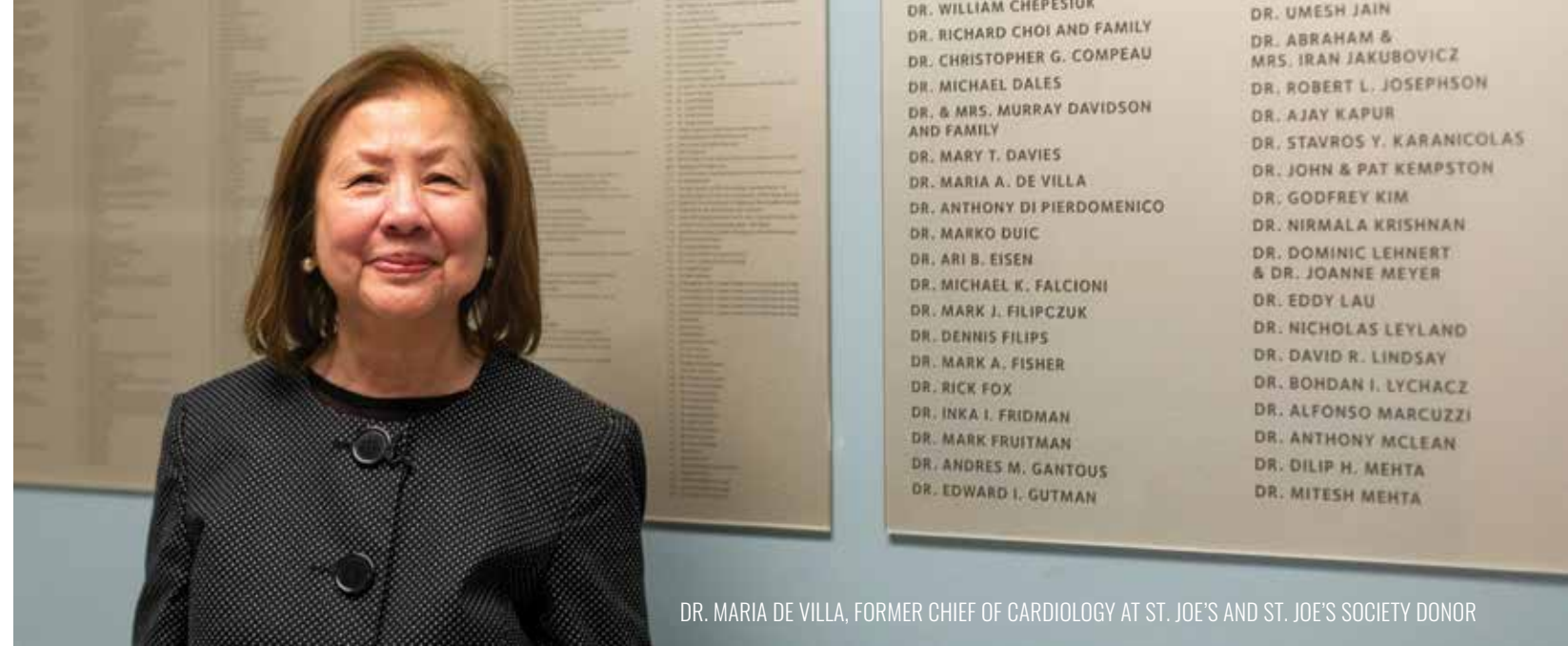
A sold-out St. Joe's **Fall Classic Golf Tournament** raised over \$500,000—another record that is supporting extraordinary care in our new patient tower.

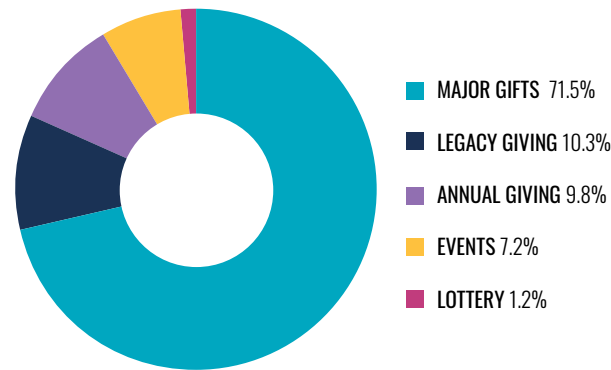

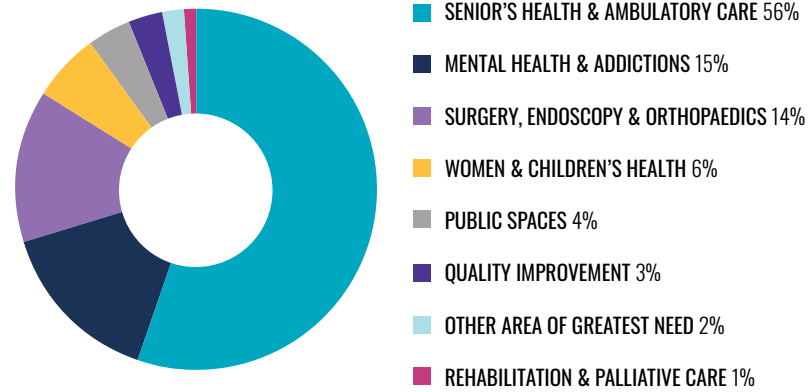
